*Subject: Admission of patient Sofia Andreevna Amelchenko*

*With reference to your request for the treatment in our Hospital for patient Sofia Andreevna Amelchenko, resident in Russia, and affected by Neuroblastoma HR, we are willing to inform you that our Hospital accepts to hospitalize the patient as planned and agreed with Francesca Del Bufalo, MD, and Prof. Franco Locatelli – Director of our Department of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology.*

*Admission will provide a first step of about 40 days with clinical and diagnostic assessments and reinduction program.*

*Eventual second step, if deemed possible, should last for about 6 months, will provide a first phase of pre-apheresis screening and apheresis procedure, on a Day Hospital basis; a second phase of CAR-T treatment with an average hospitalization of 4 weeks. Subsequently, post-discharge, follow-up checks as an outpatient for about 20 times up to 100 days post car-t infusion.*

*Total cost will be €40,000.00 for first step, and €315,000.00 for eventual second step with CAR-T treatment, if no complications arise*

*Travel costs will not be charged to our Hospital.*
